"give us an opportunity to work together on projects!" "really allow our kids to express themselves in positive ways!"


The games, toys, and books:

HUMBLE DONORS

Donors who designate AGAPE of NC as a beneficiary in their estate plans.

AGAPE of North Carolina tries to express our appreciation to each Donor who provides financial and/or other support during our Annual Giving campaigns and/or other times throughout the year. 

WE CAN TALK ABOUT IT

Book by Whitney Bunker, Review by Kia Carter

Whitney Bunker is an author, adoptive mom, and social worker who has written a wonderful children's book for the foster and adoptive community - We Can Talk About It.

Whitney's book is a guide and ongoing conversation starter for families who need support in talking about honest feelings and thoughts surrounding their child's journey. It leads parents and caregivers through various scenes of familiar expressions of children experiencing foster care or adoption. As added support, there are nine parental tips at the back of the book. **We Can Talk About It** helps families with kids ages 4-9 find more intentional dialogue.



In her video review, Kia talks personally about how useful Whitney's book can be for recognizing and addressing questions that kids may have while they're navigating foster care or adoption.

Whitney also offers a few downloadable coloring pages from her book. You can get them by clicking on the pictures to the right!

In a recent blog, Whitney pointed out that "There are different forms of talking... before we learn to talk, we share things with sounds and body language. Sometimes, before we learn to share with our mouth, kids learn to share with our hands. One way of 'sharing' information (a.k.a. talking) is through drawing! Even though many kids this age are technically 'talking' and reading - this doesn't always come easy to them." Whitney believes art can lead to healing. So she encourages parents and professionals to use these coloring pages to gain insight, to prompt, and to lean into creative discussions!



Staff Spotlight: CIS Investigator

LAURA MATHIS

We are so pleased to introduce Laura Mathis as AGAPE's current CIS Investigator.

Since 2008, licensed child-placing agencies, like AGAPE of North Carolina, have been allowed to act as Confidential Intermediaries between birth parents and adult adoptees, adult lineal descendants of a deceased adoptee, and/or parents of adoptees under the age of 21.

Such persons may contact AGAPE for Confidential Intermediary Services (CIS) and, when appropriate, AGAPE can share information and facilitate contact. As our CIS Investigator, Laura conducts the research necessary to verify identities and relationships and to collect other desired details.

About joining AGAPE's staff, Laura says that, "As a former elementary education teacher, my heart has always been drawn to helping children. When I heard about AGAPE of NC and the wonderful work they do, I knew I had to be part of it! I am blessed and honored to have the opportunity to work with AGAPE to unite those who have been adopted with their birth families."
